 - b. Provide a **DETAILED DESCRIPTION** of the metadata element set you would use and discuss **THREE (3)** reasons for your choice *(13.5 marks)*
- 4. There are issues a metadata creator should consider when selecting elements
 - a. Define elements (1.5 mark)
 - b. Describe **FOUR (4)** elements typically used in a metadata element set and explain the functionality of each. (6 marks)
 - c. Provide a detailed explanation of **THREE (3)** of the issues a metadata creator should consider when selecting elements for a given digital collection. Use examples for each. *(7.5 marks)*

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- 5. There are elements which require that the values be taken from a controlled list.
 - a. Explain the reason for this. (1.5 marks)
 - b. The subject element is one such element which requires that the values be taken from a controlled list. Describe the **THREE** (3) elements which indicate the subject content of the resource. (4.5 marks)
 - c. Discuss **TWO (2)** types of controlled vocabularies available to metadata creators. Use examples for each. *(9 marks)*
- 6. Metadata is critical to resource discovery. Increasingly, librarians are called upon to manage metadata projects involving digital images.
 - a. Define metadata (1.5 marks) and describe the **THREE (3)** primary types of metadata and their functions. *(4.5 marks)*
 - b. Explain why it is challenging to decide on the subject content of digital images. (1.5 marks)
 - c. Discuss **THREE (3)** important guidelines for indexing digital images (7.5 marks)
