SECTION B

- 4. Discuss the performance of a country of your choice in the global information and communication economy as a measure of its information society status.
- 5. Identify **THREE** (3) main developments that have defined the global information and communication economy since 1995 and assess current levels of participation by developing countries in this economy.
- 6. Identify and discuss the TWO (2) main trends currently evident in the global ICT economy and propose implications that these may have for countries in the English-speaking Caribbean.

SECTION C

- 7. Compare and contrast the main policy approaches and measures implemented in a Caribbean and a non-Caribbean country to facilitate deployment, assess, and use of ICT's for national development.
- 8. Comment on the main technological, economic and market developments that indicate a need for policy and regulatory reform in the telecommunications/ICT industry and provide examples of these reforms.
- 9. Reconceptualising the 'digital divide' is imperative to ensure that appropriate digital and non-digital interventions are made in narrowing the "divide". Discuss this statement in relation to the development and delivery of library services.
