- 3. Comment on the impact that ICTs have had on classical models of communication. Make reference to four (4) elements of the communication environment to substantiate your observations.

SECTION B

- 4. Assess the extent to which Jamaica's National Information System reflects performance on the following indicators for the Networked Readiness Index: (a) Government Prioritization of ICT and (b) Government Procurement of Advanced Technology Products. Provide examples from the library and documentation services to ground your arguments.
- 5. On a scale of zero (0) to ten (10), with ten (10) being the highest, how would you rate the provisions in Jamaica's 2030 Development Plan for enhancing a beneficial relationship between information, communication and society? Explain the rating that you give.
- 6. What are the three (3) main developments that defined the transition to the post-1995 period in the global information and communication economy? Explain the impact of each on the provision of information and communication services globally.

- 7. Briefly explain your view on how countries in Latin America and the Caribbean should approach development of the following areas
 - The ICT infrastructure
 - Production of ICT goods and services;
 - Use of advanced ICT applications
 - o ICT skills in the population
