- 2. Describe the MARC Bibliographic Record Format and elaborate on FOUR (4) benefits the library community has derived from it.
- 3. Discuss the significance of bibliographic access points for the bibliographic record in the OPAC. Explain the concepts of main and added entries and the FIVE (5) main types of bibliographic access points, indicating their use as main and added entries.
- 4. Write a recommendation to a library manager **EITHER** for **OR** against the use of a bibliographic utility in a type of library of your choice. Include **FOUR** (4) pros and **FOUR** (4) cons, in making your recommendation whether <u>for</u> or <u>against</u> its use. Reference a specific bibliographic utility.
- 5. a) Elaborate on **SIX** (6) reasons for the development of the new cataloguing code *Resource Description and Access* (RDA) to replace *AACR2*.
 - b) Give **FOUR** (4) significant differences and the rationale for the differences, between *AACR2* and *RDA* other than any relationship to FRBR.
- 6. a) Describe the different types of Metadata used in bibliographic records for digital libraries.
 - b) Explain the rationale for the development of Dublin Core Metadata Element Set.
