

DEGREE PLANNING CHECKLIST

The degree planning checklist is a resource designed to assist FSS students in (i) tracking their rate of progress and programme requirements, (ii) undertaking a credit check, and (iii) seeking timely academic advising from their Department/School. It is not intended as the official confirmation of a student's eligibility to graduate. Students must obtain a GPA of 2.0 or higher in addition to at least 90 credits to be deemed eligible for graduation. The programme requirements below are applicable ONLY for the following major and year of admission/readmission/transfer/change of major.

Programme Notes:

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In additon to the above requirements, students are required to register for three (3) interships during the summer term (semester 3) of each academic year. These zero-credit courses are MGMT1424, MGMT2124 and MGMT3124. Students who refuse to attend internship at the organization at which they are placed will be required to withdraw from the programme. If students fail to submit the requested documents on time, they will be required to seek internship without the assistance of the programme coordinator.

*Students pursuing a Tourism Management major must take the appropriate Level I prerequisites to allow them to meet the level II/III Foreign Language requirement. Students without CSEC Spanish or French MUST do SPAN0101: Beginners Spanish I or FREN0101: Beginners French I, however, these courses will not satisfy the Level I foreign language requirement above. See handbook for details.

Students transferring from St. Augustine and Cave Hill Campuses who have completed all thirty Level I credits will be eligible to enter the second year of this programme. They will further be exempted from taking the language courses which must be substituted by two other Free Electives.
