



NABCEP Photovoltaic Installation Professional (PVIP) Training 2022 Online Program

North American Board of Certified Energy Practitioners® (NABCEP®) is a well-established and widely recognized certification organization worldwide for professionals in the field of renewable energy. With the growing solar market in Jamaica, there is a critical need for trained solar installers. A NABCEP PVIP Certification demonstrates the holder’s unique qualifications in the installation, design, and operation of solar PV systems.

Training Content

The NABCEP Photovoltaic Installation Professional Training Course consists of:

In-class Component – 8-week program comprised of:

- 58 hours of advanced PV training.
- 10 hours of OSHA (Occupational Safety and Health Administration) construction-related training.
- Self-paced online modules, with access to instructors throughout.
- Weekly live sessions with instructors.
- NABCEP PVIP practice exam and end-of-module quizzes.

Hands-on Field Component:

Completion of solar installations (ideally prior to start of in-class training) equaling at least 6 project credits as follows: system size of 1-99kW is 2 credits and 1MW and up is 3 credits. GSI will provide access to on-going solar installations to support those requiring additional hands-on experience.

Qualifying for NABCEP PVIP Exam

Upon successful completion of the Training Course and verification of the required field installations, you will be eligible to take the NABCEP PVIP Certification Examination. GSI will work with you to determine compliance with eligibility requirements, including ensuring all classroom training and hands-on experience is properly documented.

Training Fee:

The NABCEP PVIP training course is **US\$1,650**, including the cost of registration. The non-refundable registration fee for an individual is US\$50 (approximately JM\$7,500) and for a person working for an installation firm is US\$100 (approximately JM\$15,000).

Scholarships are available for the remainder of the course cost.
