Transportation

If you will be traveling to Jamaica and have been assigned on-campus housing, you are asked to forward your arrival information as soon as this is finalized so that arrangements can be made for you to be met at the airport. Please note that transportation is provided

for first-year students only. Students should send their arrival information to the Lodgings Office at lodgings.ossd@uwimona.edu.jm. Pick-up at the Norman Manley International Airport (NMIA) will be done Mondays to Fridays with a close-off time at 8:00 pm during the period of mid-August to the first week of September 2023.

Students arriving on the weekend (Saturday and Sunday) and students residing off-campus will need to make their own arrangements for transportation from the airport. These students are strongly encouraged to use the services of the Jamaica Union of Travelers Association (JUTA) located at the NMIA. The JUTA Company is safe and works closely with the OSSD, so they take very good care of our students. This service comes at a cost which may vary based on the number of persons in your group. Immigration

For students traveling to Jamaica, please note that all regional and international students admitted to The University of the West Indies, Mona Campus, are required to get an "Extension of Stay" visa after they have registered at The UWI Mona. Attached for your information is the Immigration Fact Sheet which outlines the "Extension of Stay" application process. The International Students Office team will help to guide you through this process. Additional information regarding this process will be provided during our orientation programme.

If you are travelling from a non-Commonwealth country or are from Nigeria, Pakistan, Sri Lanka, British Virgin Islands, or the Cayman Islands, you may be required to obtain an Entry Visa before arriving in Jamaica. Please check your status using the following link: <https://www.pica.gov.jm/immigration/entry-visa-requirements>. If you need a visa to enter Jamaica, please contact the nearest Jamaican Embassy for further guidance. The Entry Visa acts as a landing permit; therefore, students will still need to acquire an "Extension of Stay" a few weeks after arriving in Jamaica. Please refer to the Immigration Fact Sheet for more details.

We are happy to help you and welcome communication from you. Our office is open Monday through Friday from 8:30a.m. to 4:30p.m. We encourage you to visit our website at <https://www.mona.uwi.edu/iso/> for more information that you may find useful as you prepare to come to Jamaica.
